## ASSISTANT RACE OFFICER GUIDANCE AND SAFETY CHECK LIST

This is a great opportunity to learn more about the rules of racing. This check list provides a summary of key points

- ➤ Please arrive 1 hour 30 minutes before a club start to meet with the Race Officer, Safety boat helm and crew
- ➤ Instructions for race preparation can be found in the Guide to Racing folder in the Race Tower
- Assist the RO with the following
  - o Checking signing out sheets match participants on the water
  - o Carrying out Radio Checks with safety boat at earliest opportunity
  - o Keeping track of boats on the water
  - o Communicating with the safety boat
  - o Recording boat timings during the race
  - Collating results
  - o Checking signing back in and all have returned sato shore
  - Ensure any adverse events e.g. casualties are documented in the accident book and appropriate action taken
- ➤ For all aspects of race management refer to the HPYC Race Officer guide.
